

## INFORMATION OBLIGATION

### Processing of personal data

*(annex to the Regulations of the Conference/Event organized by the JU)*

In accordance with Art. 13 of the Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council (EU) 2016/679 of 27 April 2016 on the protection of people with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/WE (General Data Protection Regulation, hereinafter "GDPR"), the Jagiellonian University informs that:

1. The Administrator of the Conference/Event Participant's personal data is the Jagiellonian University, ul. Gołębia 24, 31-007 Kraków, represented by the Rector of the JU.
2. The Jagiellonian University has appointed a Data Protection Officer. Contact with the Officer is possible by e-mail: [iod@uj.edu.pl](mailto:iod@uj.edu.pl) or by phone number 12 663 12 25 – from Monday to Friday, between 8:00 and 15:00.
3. The Participant's personal data will be processed for the purpose of:
  - a. execution of the contract, the subject of which is participation in the Summer Workshop on Interval Methods, SWIM2026, as well as for the purpose of registering participation in the Conference/Event based on a contract concluded by accepting the Regulations (Art. 6 sec. 1 lit. b of the GDPR). The Conference/Event is organized on June 22-24, 2026 on-site;
  - b. ensuring the safety of the Conference/Event in accordance with the Video Surveillance Regulations applicable at the JU available at <https://bip.uj.edu.pl/> and the information obligation regarding the processing of image in video surveillance available at <https://iod.uj.edu.pl/monitoring-wizyjny> based on Art. 6 sec. 1 lit. e of the GDPR – in relation to video surveillance data.
4. Providing personal data by the Participant:
  - a. in relation to the data referred to in point 3 lit. a above is necessary to conclude the contract and participate in the Conference/Event;
  - b. in relation to the data referred to in point 3 lit. c above is voluntary, but failure to provide them – due to the obligation to ensure the safety of the Participants - results in the inability to participate in the Conference/Event.
5. The Participant's personal data provided in the registration form will not be shared with third parties.
6. The Participant's personal data will not be transferred to third countries (outside the European Economic Area) nor to international organizations.
7. The recipients of the Participant's personal data are entities providing IT support in the organization of the Conference/Event – including the entity providing the software used for registration for the event.

8. The Participant's personal data provided in the registration form will be processed until the end of the Conference/Event, and then for the period of limitation of claims that may arise from participation in the Conference/Event. Video surveillance data will be processed for a maximum of 3 months.
9. The Participant has the right to: obtain information about the processing of personal data and the rights vested in accordance with the GDPR, access the content of their data and rectify it, as well as the right to erase personal data from the administrator's filing systems (unless further processing is necessary for the performance of a legal obligation or in order to establish, exercise or defend claims), and the right to restriction of processing, data portability, to object to processing – in cases and under conditions specified in the GDPR.
10. The Participant's personal data will not be subject to automated decision-making or profiling.
11. The Participant has the right to lodge a complaint with the President of the Personal Data Protection Office if they consider that the processing of their personal data violates the provisions of the GDPR.
